FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each. A supplemental nomination fee of \$750 may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. \$100 to pass the entry box, \$500 additional to start, with \$400,000 guaranteed to be divided*: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 6% to fourth and 4% to fifth. *All starters, excluding starters finishing first through fifth, shall be paid \$7,500 each and the remaining purse monies will then be divided as described above. Weight: 124 lbs. Winners of a Grade/Group I race in 2024-2025 to carry an additional 2 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded/Group race in 2024-2025 allowed 2 lbs.; of \$60,000 in 2025 4 lbs., (Maiden, Claiming, and Starter races not considered), Maidens 8 lbs. A field of 14 starters will be drawn with preference given as follows: Graded/Group stakes winners in order (I-II-III), stakes winners, Graded/Group stakes placed horses (2nd place, 3rd place) in order (I-II-III), stakes placed horses in order (2nd place, 3rd place), winners, highest career earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey.

MAD HOUSE set a pressured pace on the inside and shook clear leaving the turn while moving off the i nside and then widened the margin under right handed crop urging and remained clear to the wire to score. GATESKEEPER tracked the early pace from the inside to the quarter pole, moved out and came four wide off the bend and ran on gamely to the wire to gain the place award. FIRE PIT pressed the winner from tyhe outside and came three wide off the bend and kept on willingly before fading late while staying on for the show award. BARNES fell back to trail after a furlong despite being under urging, then settled into stride on the turn while in the two to three path, swung wide leaving the turn and had a late rally for the minor rewards. RETRIBUTION was settled early three wide, then advancwed three to five wide on the turn and came six wide off the bend and had no late kick. NEOEQUOS tracked the early pace from the outside and was three to four wide on the turn and came five wide off the bend and weakened. WAX BOX was settled back early on the

inside, two wide on the turn but lacked a serious rally. ALCHEMISM was settled back two wide early and failed to menace. DONUT GOD tracked the early pace in between rivals and fell back nearing the quarter pole sans empty in the drive. FRIDAY SURPRISE was settled and moved to the inside on the turn and retreated.
