CHUCK'S LAW stalked the pacesetters outside, bid into the stretch then edged away late under steady drive. NO MOR STONES dueled initial quarter, led to mid-stretch, was collared and weakened. HEPHEPCUTDOWNNETS shook loose before half mile, vied on the final turn, tired but just lasted for the show. WILL'S MUSIC dropped far behind then advanced well inside through the stretch. CENTAUR CENTRAL lacked speed outside then faded in the stretch. FINAL JOKE dropped back inside early and lacked a response. GRANDE FELINO saved ground off the leaders then weakened steadily.
