FIRST TRUMPET led narrowly outside, moved clear before the half, lost the advantage at the quarter pole then came again late to gain the decision. TAVERN TIME stalked the pacesetter three wide, led into the stretch but was outdueled to the wire. RIVER'S GAMBLE prompted the pace along the inside and held on gamely to the finish. FULLY COMMITTED settled off the leaders three wide then proved empty in the lane. RILEY'S ROCKSTAR rated wide behind the pacesetters and gave way in the stretch. RUN CORY RUN trailed for five furlongs inside and faltered. FLUFF THE PILLOW dropped back wide and was never in contention.
