CHELONIAN led under pressure inside, lost the lead on the final turn then came again gamely to gain the decision. HEY PORTER engaged the winner early, held a narrow lead on the final turn then was outdueled to the wire. ADMIRAL'S WAVE reserved inside the pacesetters, bid then flattened out in the stretch. MAJESTIC LION broke very slowly and raced far back, saved ground and was no factor. BATTER UP BUD broke slowly, dropped well behind and had no response. LIBERTY RUNNER broke sluggishly and was never in contention. GREAT ESCAPE bore out into the backstretch, chased outside and gave way. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the start of the race.
