TRULLI WARRIOR dueled briefly, took over after the initial quarter then drew off driving in a dominating score. KEEPING THE FAITH was put to urging pursuing winner on the turn and proved second best. PASTERO chased inside, angled out in the stretch and up for the show. GUS' TEN forced the pace inside, chased the winner on the turn and faded. EXTRASEXYMCSTEEMEE lacked speed racing wide and was always outrun. TAP THE DEVIL dropped back early and trailed throughout.
