TUNISIAN SPRING raced off the pace in the two path, bid inside, was in tight late, recovered and was just up at the wire. BEYONDEXPECTATIONS dueled outside, shook loose on the turn, came over inside the sixteenth pole and was nailed. MARVELOUS MO outrun early, swung wide into the stretch and closed well. WILLISAU saved ground off the pace, moved closer on the turn then faltered. ALCHEMISM dropped far behind then offered some late energy while no threat. HOLY SYNERGY led under pressure initial quarter mile then gave way.
