GET SET pressed the pacesetter outside, led into the stretch then edged away in the final eighth. YULETIDE GALLOP hustled to the front inside, was collared at the quarter pole and battled gamely before tiring. TRY HARDER went after pacesetters on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. DEVIL'S CAY dropped off the pace and lacked a solid rally. STARLORD urged close up outside then began fading on the turn. LUCKY DUDE chased four wide down the backstretch and faltered. CISCO KID was eased back soon after the start and trailed throughout.
