SOAR RICHARD stalked close up between rivals, bid between horses at the quarter pole, took charge in upper stretch and drew clear under urging. STILLWATER MOON vied inside for the lead, dueled with the winner into the stretch, was no match and well clear for the place spot. DAVOLA vied outside for the lead, dueled on the turn, came three wide into the lane, weakened and held for third. BIG DOSSER tracked close up on the inside, chased inside on the turn and lacked a bid. PRIVATE CABANA raced off the rail, off the pace, chased on the turn and had no rally. TAPORICAL bobbled at the start and was bumped, outrun early and failed to threaten. FASTIDIOUS was bumped at the start, stalked three wide, chased on the turn, went four wide at the quarter pole and faded. PLANET was off slowly, raced off the pace inside and did not factor.
