WAVE RIDER was off slowly, raced five wide on the first turn, then stalked three wide, chased three wide on the far turn, rallied into the stretch, dueled with MONSTER MAX in the final furlong and gamely prevailed. MONSTER MAX raced four wide early, then pulled while close up outside, vied outside for command, took over at the half mile marker, dueled into the stretch, dug in gamely on the rail and battled to the finish. GREY BULL raced four wide on the clubhouse turn, settled three wide off the pace, chased on the far turn, closed belatedly on the rail and got third. QUAKER CITY checked while drifting out on the first turn, then tracked inside, chased on the far turn, angled out and lacked a stretch rally. HIGHER SENSE stumbled badly at the start, steadied on the first turn, raced off the pace between rivals, chased on the far turn and had no rally. LORDEN'S PRIDE steadied on the first turn, raced off the pace inside, chased outside on the far turn and did not factor. AUSSIE'S HEIR set the pace, then vied inside, chased and gave way.
