BOUTWELL TIME settled off the pace outside, bid on the turn then drew away eagerly in moderate drive. BUTTER KISSES raced far behind, moved strongly circling her field on the turn and stretch. MO ATTITUDE was sluggish early then finished with good late energy. LITTLE COCOA BEAN earned narrow advantage outside for half a mile then faltered. TRUTHORCONSEQUENCE moved close up for half mile and faded. MUSIC CLARIFICATION lacked speed, weakened on the turn and was no factor. CASILDA broke slowest, rushed to contention inside then faded. QUERCUS raced within range for half mile and gave way. CELESTIAL SPEED flashed speed initial quarter mile and stopped.
