J D FACTOR controlled the pace, widened in the stretch and stayed safe under moderate pressure. DUKE OF GLOUCESTER outrun early, saved ground, angled out in the stretch and closed strongly. LATTa fanned wide on the first turn, bid inside in the stretch and rallied. MARGIN OF AIR raced in closest pursuit of the winner to mid-stretch and faltered. REAL SENSATION broke awkwardly, moved closer on the final turn then flattened out. DEPOSITION outrun early, moved very wide on the final turn and lacked bid. FEELING WOOZY moved close up for half mile and gave way. MARGIE'S FUN SON was in tight between rivals into the first turn then trailed.
