KATE'S GOLDEN DUDE rated inside the pacesetter, angled out in the stretch and drew off quickly. DIAMOND HEIST raced in closest pursuit of pacesetter, bid, easily second best. FIRST MONEY lacked speed, advanced extremely wide and closed well. LORD WINSALOT settled off the pace, swung wide into stretch then flattened out. MEGA CHARLIE hustled to the front, was collared after half mile and faded. CANTARO dropped off the pace in the two path, bid into the stretch and faded. OMAHA EIGHT chased well behind and lacked a response. CATIRE VIZCAYA moved close up wide down the backstretch and gave way. CHIP'S FRIEND dwelt at the start and trailed throughout.
