SHELLEY'S SECRET was off slow at the break and chased the pace from the three path and brushed with a rival entering the turn and came five to four wide in the upper and pulled ahead of the leader handily to prove best. LUCKYBLINGMOUNTAIN was bumped outwards at the start and rushed up then set an unchallenged pace from the two to three path and kept on in the stretch but weakened while holding a clear second best. RED HOT SHOT chased the pace from four path and brushed with a rival entering the turn and came three wide into the upper but needed kick while besting the rest. MAGICAL MAX was a step slow at the break and tipped to the inside and raced in the three to four path on the turn and bumped a rival while splitting nearing the five sixteenths marker and came five wide in the upper and improved. HE'S THE GOAT settled back in the six path early on around the turn and swung about nine wide into the upper and vied in the stretch for the minor awards. GOSPEL UP was settled mid-pack through the early stages in the four path and came six to seven wide in the upper and drifted out a little late but was outfinished. DI RISATA MOLTO broke outwards and bumped a rival then raced at the back in the three path and made a mild gain. PASS THE ROSES was bumped at the start and was up early in the two path and steadily faded coming around the turn. SIZE I WEAR broke inwards at the break and bumped into a rival then trailed the field early on and swung wide in the upper but was no factor.

PRINCE PIERRE settled back early on and tipped to the inside on the rail then came out slightly entering the upper to be two wide but was no menace. THE BIRDMAN raced mid-pack in the four path early then was bumped nearing the five sixteenths and tired out. TURBO ROCKET was a step slow at the break and rushed up to be forwardly placed on the inside then steadily faded coming around the turn.

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
