ESSENTIAL COFFEE settled back early in the four path and came out six wide in the upper looking for an opening and tipped out a bit then vied late in the drive and just pulled ahead before to wire to prove best. HARVEY'S FINNISH stumbled at the break and raced near the back in the five path then swung out eight wide into the upper and vied late but was just up for the place award. LADY BELLE broke outwards and raced in the mid-pack from the three to four path then vied in the stretch six to five wide but was outkicked in the final yards. PRIVATE DEBBIE chased the pace around the turn two wide and came four wide into the upper and vied from the inside but just needed more. TEXAS SPEED QUEEN shifted to the inside early and dueled for pace from the rail then weakened late in the stretch. LADY BEAU was off pace in the three path then swung out ten wide into the upper and improved late in the drive. LAMORNA INN chased the pace around the turn from the three path and came five wide into the upper but weakened. KISS MY DICE settled back along the inside early on then tipped out four to seven wide through the stretch but needed kick. STORM AFTER DARK was reluctant loading in the gate and raced in the two path towards the back of the pack then tipped to the inside off the turn but lacked a bid. JALAPENA LENA broke outwards and dueled for pace from the two path then came three to four wide in the upper and faded late. JEWLZ was up early and shifted inside then tracked the pace from the two path then came three wide into the upper but tired out. AUNT PENNY was off pace on the inside but was no factor.
