NINIA was off a step slow then tracked two-deep through the early stages, was under a drive early but still lost ground to the leaders through the turn, bid four-wide into the stretch, and produced a strong rally under steady handling and was along in plenty of time for the win. MARETTE broke well and prompted the pace from the inside, backed off going into the turn, then came back on in the final furlong to gain second. EAGLE VISION dueled outside of NATIVE CHARMER, bid three wide into the stretch, ran on well, but was outfinished for the win. CODE OF THE SOUTH broke well but lacked early speed and dropped back well off the pace, tracked three-wide, raced on the left lead through the stretch, then was gaining late once straightened out. NATIVE CHARMER broke well, dueled up front closest to the inside up the backstretch and through the turn, finished well under strong handling, but gave way in the final yards. PAYNTER'S PALETTE off slow, raced at the back of the pack and mildly improved in the later stages while never a serious threat. LUMINA got away well, settled in the middle of the pack early, advanced from the three-eighths pole to loom a threat approaching the stretch, but flattened out in the final furlong and faded.
