BERTANI was settled then rallied four wide on the turn, was in a long drive and wore down the pacesetter in late stretch to be best. CARIBBEAN DREAM set the early pace then drew off on the turn, was in a long drive in the stretch but could not last in the final strides. REMEMBER BIG JIM was unhurried early then rallied on the turn while five wide, was making a bid in the stretch but was no menace late. MISINFORMATION stumbled at the start then settled, rallied three wide on the turn but was no threat in late stretch. STONEY BRICK ROAD was unhurried early then raced four wide on the turn and was no threat. SAINT BENJI chased the early pace while three wide, was used up then gave way. STORMFORGED pressed the early pace while inside, was hard used then gave way. CHANGE OF COMMAND was two wide on the then stopped and was eased up in late stretch and walked off.
