GORRONO RANCH was hustled away from the gate and set the pace while racing off the rail, was roused at the top of the stretch and responded well, winning easily. MELLY'S BIRKIN chased the pace early along the inside before angling out nearing the 3/16 pole and ran on through the lane but was no match for the winner. CRIME SCENE was allowed to settle early and saved ground through the turn before being asked along the inside into the lane and had the best stride late. SPEAKER BABY was reluctant to load into the gate and stumbled at the start before moving up to race mid-pack, then angled five wide into the stretch and was brushed by DESERT FOLLOWING near the 1/8 pole then ran on late. DESERT FOLLOWING rated in the second flight early with a three wide trip before drifting out and brushing SPEAKER BABY near the 1/8 pole then gave way late in the lane. OVER REACTED was in tight early between horses and dropped back to the back of the field, racing at the back through the turn before gaining too late in the stretch. ZIAH Y G was shuffled back between horses after the start and was void of early speed before making a five wide bid on the turn but flattened out in the stretch.
