CANOGA was three wide into the turn and rallied strongly to take command then drew off in mid stretch and was best in the end. JERRY'S LADY was settled then rallied wide in upper stretch, was gaining ground and was second best in the end. RIVER BOMBER set a pressured pace while two wide into the turn, was in a long drive but weakened in late stretch. COWGIRL BUCKAROO pressed the pace while inside into the turn, was hard used then gave way. STAR STATIS bobbled at the start then rallied two wide into the turn making a bid then flattened out in the drive. G'S TWISTED TALE was unhurried early and raced three wide on the turn but was no threat. SPACED OUT trailed throughout.
