DEVIOUS DIVA raced off the pace on the outside up the backstretch, began a bid from the four path coming around the turn and kicked clear. CRYPTIC MISS settled in the middle of the pack on the inside through the opening quarter, navigated the turn from the three path, began a bid entering the stretch and gained ground late. LITTLE IRIS dueled on the inside up the backstretch, saved ground around the bend and gave way late. POSETIVELY PERFECT dueled on the outside through the early going, came around the turn in the three path, dug in in upper stretch, and weakened in the final sixteenth. MI SONRISA dueled between horses up the backstretch, continued around the turn in the two path and faded in the stretch. UNBRIDLED KISSES raced off the pace on the inside through the opening stages, swung out to the five path coming around the turn and made no bid. DA LAST TEQUILA stalked the leader on the outside up the backstretch, navigated the turn from the three and four path and tired in the lane. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
