HOLLYWOOD ICON was allowed to settled then started a run while saving ground on the far turn, was three wide in the stretch and was up in the final strides. BARBACOA was moved out to be four wide on the backstretch, then rallied on the far turn, was three wide turning for home then was four wide in the stretch but was out finished in the final strides. MR OKLAHOMA set the early pace while inside, drew off into the top of the stretch and was in a long drive but weakened in late stretch. T BONES TRICK was allowed to settled then started a rally on the far turn while four wide, made a bid but came up empty in late stretch. SEND THE BOSS was unhurried early on the rallied on the far turn, swung out to be six wide in upper stretch but was no menace in late stretch. CUPID'S THUNDER was unhurried early then rallied five wide on the far turn but was no menace in late stretch. BOBBY BRINKLEY was allowed to settled while three wide on the backstretch, was used up then gave way. THE LAST MOXY pressed the early pace while two wide, was hard used then gave way on the far turn.
