CHIVALROUS was settled early on then rallied four wide on the turn, was in a strong drive and powered to the front in late stretch to be best. DUTTON'S SONG was unruly in the gate then dueled for the lead from the inside, was in a long drive but weakened in late stretch. GUN FIRE bumped on the backstretch then chased the pace while three wide into the turn, made a bid but came up empty in late stretch. MELLENCAMP was forced out and bumped hard on the backstretch then raced inside on the turn but was no menace. TIME FOR MUSIC was settled then rallied four wide in upper stretch but was no threat. STRONG POTENTIAL was saving ground on the turn then made a mild rally while two wide in the stretch but was no threat. CUCAMONGA bore out and bumped hard on the backstretch then dueled for the lead while two wide into the turn, was used up and stopped in late stretch. DASTADLY DAN was in tight and pin balled around between rivals then taken up, was settled and lacked a rally in the stretch. A steward's inquiry was held concerning the run down the backstretch, After reviewing the film's, no action was taken.
