FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. ACCREDITED OKLAHOMA FOALS. No nomination fee. \$600 to pass the entry box. Starters to pay \$500 additional with \$50,000 guaranteed by Remington Park and an additional \$20,000 plus from the Oklahoma Bred Fund. Supplementary nominations may be made at time of entry for a fee of \$2,200, which qualifies to start. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of entry. High Weights Preferred, Then Highest Lifetime Earnings Will Be Used In Determining The Order Of Preference Of Horses with Equal Weights on the Scale. Earnings will be determined according to statistics provided by Equibase. This race will be limited to 12 starters. The guaranteed money and OBF funds to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 111% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Fees include a custom saddle towel that will be presented to each entrant. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. (If management deems it necessary to take this race off the Turf, it will be run at a distance of 1 Mile on the main track.). (S)

EXCAPING THE BLUES went to the front to set all the pace, had a mild challenge going into the final turn but able to fend off rival to draw clear and held on late for the win. COUNTRY CAPER was allowed to settled down the backstretch then made a four wide rally having his best strides late to be up for the place. TAP THE DOT was unhurried through the final turn then tipped out to three wide in upper stretch to make a late run and was outnoddod for the place. GOOD SWIMMER raced off the pace while saving ground throughout, showed late effort in the stretch drive but was outfinished in the final jumps. SONIC POSSE lost footing at the start, rushed up to prompt the pace down the backstretch then made a mild challenge on the leader but couldn't collar and tired late. NUMBER ONE DUDE was forwardly place off the pace down the backstretch then moved up from three wide on the final turn and tried to go between horses at the top of the stretch but lacked room, lost action and dropped back.
