CAWKAB was unhurried through the turn while saving ground, tipped out to five wide near the three sixteenths pole for the late rally and won going away. AXTON broke sharply and raced off the pace to midway through the turn then made a rebid from five wide to take the lead near the eighth pole but was caught in the final yards. SUPER BRADY vied for the lead from the inside but floated out in upper stretch and was outkicked. LEA ME BE raced close up while running four wide, took a brief lead midway through the turn and was empty late. CLAY'S BLACK OPAL vied for the lead from three wide to the quarter pole and tired. JOHNNY APPLESEED trailed the field through the turn and was not a threat. JUST OKIE was forwardly place while racing on the inside but lacked the late response. TIGER DAD rushed to a brief narrow lead from two wide to the three furlong marker before giving way.
