RED HOT SHOT stalked the pace while two wide into the turn, rallied and was three wide in the stretch, was in a strong drive and powered to the front in late stretch. PASS THE ROSES dueled for the lead while two wide into the turn, was in a long drive but tired in late stretch. DI RISATA MOLTO stalked the pace while three wide on the turn, rallied turning for home then flattened out in late stretch. THE BIRDMAN chased the early pace while two wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the turn then was no menace in late stretch. GOSPEL UP dueled for the lead while inside, was hard used then gave way in the stretch. KID COMMISH was inside and saving ground on the turn then failed to menace. WEST AZTECA was unhurried early then no threat. COFFEE CREAM was unhurried early and trailed.
