LOVE ME A SUNSET chased the early pace while two wide into the turn, dueled from the inside turning for home then was in a long drive and held sway in the end. CAPETOWN CANDY rallied four wide on the turn then was gaining ground in late stretch to finish full of run in the end. KINKY MOON was settled then rallied inside in the stretch, was making up some ground but was no menace. RAINBOW SMILES was unhurried early then made a mild rally while two wide in the stretch but was no threat. NORTH EAST STAR (IRE) was well placed while three wide on the backstretch, rallied on the turn and dueled for the lead while two wide turning for home, was in a long drive then faltered in late stretch. COURAGEOUS CAPPEN stumbled at the start then stalked the pace while inside into the turn, was used up then gave way. CHICA COMPETITIVA showed good early speed and was used up then stopped after a half.
