CAMPFIRE CREED was saving ground into the turn then made a bid three wide at the quarter pole, angled back to the inside in upper stretch and took command in mid stretch and was in a strong drive to be best in late stretch. LOGICAL MYTH broke slow from the gate then was hustled along to be in good position into the turn, rallied four wide in upper stretch and was making up ground but hung in late stretch. MY GOOD GOOD BOY was unhurried early then rallied and was five wide in the stretch, closed ground willingly in late stretch to finished well. SHADOWLESS was unhurried early then rallied and was six wide in the stretch, was gaining ground but was no menace. FORT HOOD dueled for the lead from the inside, was hard used in upper stretch and gave way. MEGA SHACK was inside and saving ground on the turn but was no menace. SHARP LORENZO dueled for the lead while two wide, was hard used then gave way.
