CALIBRATE was settled in the early going then raced two wide, rallied on the far turn moving out to be four wide turning for home, was in a strong drive and powered to the front in late stretch to be best in the end. ONE TIME MARK stalked the pace while three wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn and was still three wide in the stretch and dug in but was second best in the end. NEWS AT NINE was stalking the pace while inside on the backstretch, was looking for acing room on the far turn then was blocked repeatedly in the stretch and angled out four wide in late stretch to closed fast and was probably best. TREVAGGIO was shuffled back on the first turn from the inside, was settled on the backstretch then made a bid and swung out to be five wide in upper stretch and was gaining ground in late stretch. MONGOLIAN MEMORY dueled for the lead while inside, was in a long drive then weakened in mid stretch. INDY ROAD dueled for the lead while two wide into the far turn then faltered in the stretch. WHISKEY NOT WINE raced four wide on the backstretch then failed to menace in the stretch. BENDER was unhurried early and was no threat.
