QUALITYSOULOFMINE was allowed to settled in the early going, rallied two wide on the far turn then blocked behind the leaders, angled out to be three wide in mid stretch and split rivals and drew off late. ATREIDESREFLECTION was stalking the early pace while two wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn take command inside the furlong marker but was unable to sustained that bid in the end. C. P. A. JIM was allowed to settled while racing three wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn and was four wide in upper stretch but hung in late stretch. REMITTANCE was unhurried early on then rallied on the far turn, was two wide for the stretch drive and closed willingly but was not enough. JOE'S CANDY was allowed to settled then raced three wide on the backstretch, made a bid five wide in upper stretch but was too late. OLD BOYS CLUB set the early pace, drew off then was in a long drive and weakened. GOSPEL DON stalked the pace while inside, made a bid but was used up and gave way.
