PRAYFORPEACE stalked the pace while inside into the turn, rallied to take command at the top of the stretch, drew away and was clearly much the best. SOUL SACRIFICE chased the early pace while inside, made a bid in upper stretch but was no match for the winner in late stretch. TEAM GORMLEY stalked the pace while three wide into the turn, made a bid but was no menace in late stretch. WORTH LOOKING was allowed to settled then raced two wide on the turn and was no menace in late stretch. MO SATURDAYS set the early pace then was in a long drive and faltered in the stretch. HELLO HOT ROD was unhurried early then raced two wide on the turn and was no threat. TENTH STREET DON was unhurried early and saved ground on the turn but was no threat. LANDLORD raced three wide on the turn and faltered in the stretch.
