RAZORS EDGE had his head turned just as the gates opened and got left at the start, was settled then rallied and angled out to be five wide in upper stretch, closed ground strongly and was up in the final strides. BUSINESS AS USUAL rallied four wide on the turn making a strong bid, gained the lead in mid stretch then was all out but was caught in the final strides. LIGHTSOUTSCARLETT pressed the pace while three wide on the turn, was in a long drive then faltered in late stretch. WAVER rallied four wide on the turn to upper stretch, made a bid but came up empty in late stretch. SECURED rallied on the turn then was two wide in the stretch but was no threat. SAY AS I SAY was unhurried early then raced three wide in the stretch but was no threat. KATIES SPIRIT pressed the pace while two wide into the turn, was used up then gave way. UNBRIDLED KISSES was inside and saving ground on the turn but came up empty in the drive. CABO COWGIRL set the early pace while being pressured, was used up then stopped. FOOLISH AFFAIR raced five wide into the turn and was through after a half then gave way.
