Weights: Three-year-olds 119 lbs.; Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 once in 2026 allowed 2 lbs., Non Winners of \$25,000 once in 2026 allowed 4 lbs., Non winners of \$18,000 in 2026 allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered). High Weights Preferred on the Scale, Highest Lifetime Earnings Will Be Used In Determining The Order Of Preference Of Horses with Equal Weights on the scale. Earnings will be determined according to statistics provided by Equibase. This race will be limited to fourteen starters. The guaranteed money to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. HOLA JOEY was well placed while two wide into the turn, rallied three wide in upper stretch, was in a long drive between rivals and prevailed in deep stretch. YO BANANA BOY stalked the pace then rallied four wide turning for home, was in a strong drive on the outside and dug in gamely but hung in the final strides. HEAVENVILLE set a well handled pace from the start, drew off into the turn then was in a long drive but tired in late stretch. PERFECT MAGIC was unhurried early then rallied four wide in upper stretch and closed ground willingly in late stretch. RIDGEWOOD RUNNER was allowed to settled then failed to menace. TAYLOR'S VERSION chased the early pace while inside into the turn, was sued up then gave way.
