TWELVE VOLT was settled early then rallied and was five wide on the turn, was in a strong drive in the stretch to be best in the end. BROCK ON BY dueled for the lead while two wide into the turn, was in a long drive in the stretch, gamely dug in but weakened in late stretch. STANS HOME RUN was unhurried early then rallied and swung out to be six wide in upper stretch, closed ground willingly in late stretch. JOHNNY APPLESEED was unhurried early then rallied while moving out to be seven wide in upper stretch, closed ground willingly and finished well. HAMAZING WISDOM was allowed to settled then rallied ten wide turning for home and was gaining ground in late stretch. FORT HOOD rallied four wide on the turn making a bid in upper stretch but was

flattened out in the drive. PERLIANO rallied while five wide on the turn making a bid but came up empty in late stretch. DERBY DATE was pinched back after the start then settled, rallied five wide on the turn but was no menace in the stretch. BAREFOOT SAMURAI was unhurried early then was no threat. ROYALLY was unhurried early and failed to menace. CLEMENTS RIDE chased the early pace while inside, was used up then gave way. CAPTAIN JACK showed early speed while two wide, was used up and gave way. TWO WORLDS dueled for the lead while inside, was hard used then stopped in the stretch.
