WHISKEY DRINKER settled the early pace while inside, rallied two wide on the far turn to take command, drew off in mid stretch and was much the best in the end. JANES GIRLS was unhurried early then rallied three wide on the far turn, was gaining ground in late stretch to be up for the place in the end. FLAT OUT FANCY was allowed to settled while two wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn but was no menace in late stretch. GOSPEL EXPRESSION set the early pace, was in a long drive into the far turn and weakened in the drive. WILD GOLD RUSH was allowed to settled then failed to menace. SEATTLE WILDCAT was unhurried early then no threat in the stretch. SKY ECHO was inside into the turn and was no threat. SANDY CREEK was through early while three wide and gave way.
