LEGENDARY LORE was allowed to settled while inside on the backstretch, rallied three wide at the quarter pole and was in a long sustained drive in the stretch to be best in the end. SHARP SPARK was unhurried early then rallied four wide on the far turn, was in a long drive but hung in late stretch. DON'TASK DON'TTELL pressed the early pace while two wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn to take command, was in a strong drive but weakened in the stretch. STUMPY'S LOVE SONG was allowed to settled while inside then failed to menace. MACH TWO set a even pace from the start, was used up then gave way on the far turn. FROM THE HEART trailed throughout then was equine ambulance off the track after the race.
