AMADORA'S EMPIRE stalked the pace while inside in the early going, moved out to be three wide into the far turn for clear running room, ranged up to take command on the far turn then was in a long drive to be best in the end. SUMMERTIMEE set the pace from the start, was in a long drive on the far turn to late stretch and weakened but held the place safe in the end. GRACE GIVEN was allowed to settled then rallied four wide on the far turn making a bid but came up empty in late stretch. IUKA MISS chased the early pace while two wide, was used up then faltered in the stretch. GLOBAL HOLIDAY stalked the pace from the inside, made a bid on the far turn then faltered in the stretch drive. CAPETOWN CANDY trailed throughout.
