PARKWAY chased the early pace then rallied two wide on the turn, was in a long drive to take command inside the furlong marker and drew off in late stretch. DEVIL'S MISCHIEF chased the early pace while two wide, rallied then was inside in the stretch but weakened in late stretch. RIVETAGE was settled early then raced three wide turning for home but was no menace in late stretch. WISH MAN was unhurried early then raced three wide on the turn but was no threat. BERGHEIM was inside and saving ground on the turn, made a bid two wide in the stretch but was no threat. BEAU DAY set a pressured pace while inside, was used up then gave way in the stretch. TOUCH OF GLAM (ARG) was unhurried early and raced three wide on the turn but was no threat. CLOUDY PAST was unhurried early and no factor.
