LOTTERY TICKET was saving ground on the turn then rallied inside in the stretch but was no threat to the top two. MYSTICAL CODE was allowed to settled then rallied two wide in the stretch but was no threat. LIGHTSOUTSCARLETT chased the early pace while five wide into the turn, made a bid on the to mid stretch but was no menace in late stretch. PRESLEYS TURN was unhurried early then raced five wide on the turn and failed to menace. LIGHT A SHUCK was unhurried early but was no menace. ANNA UP raced two wide on the turn and was no threat. KATIES SPIRIT vied for the lead while two wide into the turn, was used up then stopped. FIND THE LIGHT chased the early pace while four wide, was used up

then stopped. NOW HEAR THIS was unhurried early then was no factor.
