KOSCHEI vied for the early lead while inside then dropped back on the turn, rallied in upper stretch and was in a strong drive to proved best in the end.

BEYOND GRATEFUL was settled then rallied four wide on the turn, made a strong bid in mid stretch but hung in deep stretch. KARTWHEEL KIRBY vied for the lead while three wide, was in a long drive but weakened in late stretch. COACH KEV was settled then rallied five wide in the stretch, closed ground willingly in late stretch but was too late. DIALED WHO broke a step slow then settled, made a mild rally while four wide in the stretch but was no threat. WILDCAT COUNTRY vied for the lead while two wide into the turn, was hard used then gave way in the stretch. REMITTANCE raced three wide on the turn then failed to menace. WITT'S TEN TOUCH broke slow then was inside on the turn but no threat in the stretch. CHIEF VALOR was outrun. LIGHT ONE CANDLE was unhurried early and no factor. R TOO FEISTY showed good early speed but was used up and stopped.
