FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. ACCREDITED OKLAHOMA FOALS. No nomination fee. \$600 to pass the entry box at the usual time of entry. Starters to pay an additional \$500 with \$50,000 Guaranteed by Remington Park and an additional \$25,000 Plus from the Oklahoma Bred Fund. Supplementary nominations may be made at time of entry for a fee of \$2,200, which qualifies to start. Weights; 121 lbs. Non-winners of a stakes allowed 2 lbs.. Maidens allowed 4 lbs.. High weights preferred. Then Preference to Highest Lifetime Earnings of Horses with Equal Weights. Lifetime Earnings will be determined according to statistics provided by Equibase. This race will be limited to twelve (12) starters. The guaranteed money and the OBF funds to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Fees include a custom saddle towel that will be presented to each entrant. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. Lane's End Farm and the Senor Buscador Syndicate will offer a special breeding season to Senor Buscador in 2026 to the owners of the first, second and third-place finishers in the Don McNeil Stakes. ROYALAMERICAN was inside early and behind a wall of horses, was taken back then moved out to be three wide heading into the far turn, rallied four wide on the far turn then was in a strong drive in the stretch and proved best in the end. NUCLEUS set the early pace while being pressured, drew off on the far turn and in a long drive, was inside in the stretch then hung in late stretch. ZTWENTYEIGHT stalked the pace while three wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn to upper stretch but faltered in the end. DOCKET broke out at the start then was settled on the backstretch, rallied four wide on the far turn and made a mild rally but was no threat. HOW ABOUT BOB pressed the pace while inside on the backstretch, made a bid then faltered in the stretch. TITLE TALK stalked the pace while two wide and in hand off heels, was used up then gave way. SIR TRISTAN stalked the early pace while four wide on the backstretch, made a bid but was used up then stopped. I AM WHAT I AM was unhurried early and failed to menace.
