LUMINA dueled for the lead while two wide into the turn, was in a long drive then drew off in late stretch to be best. QUEEN WILHELMINA rallied four wide on the turn then made a bid in the stretch but was second best. CARAT SEEKER dueled from the inside into the turn then lugged in on the turn, dug in but faltered in late stretch. VAQUERA was two wide into the turn then was shuffled back, made a bid but came up empty in late stretch. NACHIKO was unhurried early but no threat in the stretch. ONE QUEEN was inside into the turn but was in tight and taken up dropping back on the turn and was no threat in the stretch. MUCHO VAPOR raced three wide on the turn and was no threat. GOLDEN PELICAN broke slow then was no threat.
