HEAVENVILLE set a well rated pace from the start, drew off in upper stretch and led throughout. LA HOULIGAN was unhurried early then rallied four wide on the far turn making a bid and was second best. SOUND OF VICTORY was allowed to settled while inside, saved ground on the far turn then made a bid but was no menace. CASHMEUP chased the early pace while two wide, made a bid on the far turn to mid stretch then faltered. FIRST BID was allowed to settled then raced inside on the backstretch and failed to menace. YO SOY ROY was unhurried early and no threat throughout. ABSOLUTELY CERTAIN chased the early pace while three wide on the backstretch, was used up then stopped. COLD FACT was unhurried early while four wide on the backstretch and was no threat.
