CHOICE NOT CHANCE set a pressured pace while inside, drew off in mid stretch then was kept to task to hold sway. CHARLIE DONT SURF chased the early pace while three wide on the turn, made a bid and was gaining ground to finished well. CUTTING CLASS chased the early pace while two wide on the turn, made a bid but was no menace in late stretch. BEXLEY was allowed to settled then rallied three wide on the turn making a bid but was no menace in the stretch. MYTH CONCEPTION chased the early pace while inside, was saving ground on the turn then came up empty in late stretch. LAZY Y GIRVIN rallied on the turn while four wide making a bid but flattened out in late stretch. HE'S THE GOAT was unhurried early and no threat. DA AMERICAN HEART was hard to load then broke slowly from the start then bore out on the backstretch and turn and was eased up in late stretch and walked off.
