SPOILER pressed the pace while two wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn and was in a long sustained drive and proved best in the end. CARBONE set a pressured pace while inside, was well handled on the backstretch and far turn, was in a long drive in the stretch then hung in late stretch. BATTLE STRIKE was allowed to settled while three wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn and was gaining ground but was no menace in late stretch. AARON was unhurried early then made a mild rally while four wide on the far turn but was no threat in the stretch. NO TROUBLE chased the early pace while inside, was used up then gave way. DOMINANT SPIRIT chased the early pace while two wide, was hard used then stopped. TIBURON was unhurried early and outrun.
