THE KWEEN'S KING chased the early pace while two wide into the turn, rallied and was in a strong drive and was best late. GENERAL JIMBO set the early pace then drew off on the turn, was in a long drive then weakened and held the place. MAGICAL MAX raced three wide on the turn then made a mild rally but was no threat. STOOPS TORNADO raced two wide on the turn then was no menace in late stretch. FULLY FUNDED raced four wide on the turn and was no threat. FLATTER ME DAILY was unhurried early and no threat. HE'S THE GOAT chased the early pace while inside, was used up then faltered. JUST ANOTHER DREAM raced two wide then stumbled badly before the turn and was pulled up by the rider on the turn and equine ambulance off the course. A steward's inquiry was held. After reviewing the film's, no action was taken.
