RISK IT vied for the early lead while two wide then was shuffled back on the turn, rallied and moved out to be three wide for the stretch drive, was bumped then split rivals in mid stretch and powered to the front to be best. CHIVALROUS was taken back early then settled, rallied four wide in the stretch, bumped with the winner in mid stretch but was second best. STORM ON THE BEACH was settled then rallied and was five wide for the stretch drive, closed willingly in late stretch but was too late. NACHO BAR was allowed to settle then made a mild rally while three wide in the stretch but was no threat. GYPSY MISCHIEF vied for the lead while two wide into the turn, drew off on the turn then was in a long drive but weakened in late stretch. GUN SHOW was unhurried early and inside then failed to menace. HOLLYWOOD ICON was inside then dropped back and was no threat.
