## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

FEATHER LAINE broke well and went to the front, vied three-wide early, then opened up a bit and maintained a length or two advantage through the turn and widened the margin through the stretch to the wire. FLASH HUMOR was off slow, tracked in mid-pack down the backstretch, then advanced to chase FEATHER LAINE in second position through the turn, could not go with that one in the stretch, lost position to SMACKDOWN in upper stretch, but kept to task and came back on to gain the place. SMACKDOWN broke well, vied/dueled early, then ceded the front to FEATHER LAINE before the turn, dropped back to third position on the turn, then tried to come back on in the stretch, gained second in upper stretch, but was outfinished in the final yards. STUMPY'S LOVE SONG outpaced early while having to be coaxed along to keep up, kept to a steady pace, but was unable to threaten. SAND CREEK settled three-wide at the back of the field through the early running and lacked a finish. IT'S A RAINY DAY hustled up from the break to press the pace while racing along the rail, started to retreat after passing the half-mile pole, and was not a factor in the late stages.
