MO TOWN GOLD broke well, settled inside just behind the pace, slipped through an opening along the rail at the top of the stretch, then finished best under steady handling and intermittent urging to prevail. RIMROCK ROAD pressed the pace four-to-five wide, bid for the lead approaching the quarter pole, had every chance but was outkicked by the winner in the final yards. TWOSHAIS G A veered in making light contact with CAPTAIN FLATTER, then had to alter course near the five-furlong pole, raced three-deep in the tracking group, backed off near the three-furlong pole, then bid three-wide leaving the quarter pole, was not quite doing enough in the late stages, but moved up into third;. CAPTAIN FLATTER was off slowly, advanced from the back through the turn, ran on some through the stretch but was not quite doing enough to be a threat. LOVE U FATHER broke on top, went to the front with several in close pursuit, held sway through the turn while seemingly traveling well, dug in under threat in upper stretch, then weakened in the final furlong. CODY THE KID was outrun early, bid four-wide into the stretch but flattened out and was unable to threaten. PASSED PROMISE pressed the early pace four-wide to the stretch, then tired.
