IZE A BLAST lacked early speed and raced at the rear through the early running, advanced up the inside on the turn, but was without a path midway, angled out to the three path before the quarter pole, then finished up well under strong handling to get up in the last jump. STUBBY was a bit keen in the early going with the rider trying to temper the pace, became boxed in early on the turn, seemingly full of run, made a bid up the rail through a narrow opening just past the eight pole, surged to the lead, but lost the bob at the wire. PONDICHERRY broke well, then pulled to take the lead at the half-mile pole, went a length clear through the turn, had a narrow lead turning for home, fought gamely under threat from all sides but was outfinished. BUSINESS AS USUAL was mid-pack four-wide going into the turn, bid for the lead near the three-furlong pole, dueled with PONDICHERRY through the stretch but hung a bit late and missed. CHECKER'S SONG was last to break, settled between horses at the rear of the field, started to run on midway on the turn, and was mildly gaining in the late stages. BELLE BLAZE pressed the early pace three-wide, loomed approaching the stretch, but flattened out. AN AWESOME LEGACY was a bit rank early, then did not respond when asked to go on. DARETOCATCHLOVE raced three-wide and lacked a rally. LIGHT A SHUCK got away well and crossed over towards the inside to take the early lead, ceded the front to PONDICHERRY near the seven-sixteenths marker, then faded to

last on the turn.
