ALL AFLUTTER broke sharply and went to the front, held sway in front of a very compact field through the turn, dug in under threat in upper stretch battled gamely through the stretch, then got the benefit of a favorable head bob at the wire to win the photo. OKIE LOVE broke well but settled off the early pace, bided time through the turn, then was set down from the guarter pole, rallied up the rail and just missed. DA CANDY CANE tracked in second position early while under a hold, was let loose and under a drive approaching the three-furlong pole, then got stuck behind horses near the quarter pole, finished up well, but came up short. MS. HILLARY was taken back to last after a level start, shifted out to the three path before the turn, launched a three-wide bid approaching the guarter pole but was outfinished. SHORT STRETCH tracked close to the pace three-wide down the backstretch, launched a bid for the lead near the three-furlong pole, but flattened out in the final furlong. CAT TALE SKY tracked just behind the pace racing along the rail, steadied near the quarter pole, lost some momentum, and was unable to get back into contention.
