MOMACYA dueled outside of BAILEY SIOUX throughout, then edged clear in the final yards. BAILEY SIOUX broke poorly then rushed up to duel with MOMACYA for the early lead, went well clear of the others past the quarter pole, kept on trying all the way to the finish, but came up short in a solid debut run. GIFT OF GRACE lagged early, moved up into contention with a three-wide forward move through the turn, was floated out a couple of paths turning for home by WEST COAST DAY, but continued to rally and gained third while not a threat to the top two. WEST CODE LADY raced five-wide, not far from the front, finished up well under steady handling, but was unable to close the gap on the top pair. SPACED OUT settled mid-pack, came under a drive midway on the turn, but was unable to threaten. SHAMROCK N ROLL checked near the eleven-sixteenths marker, chased through the turn, then was unable to generate a rally in the stretch. GOSPEL REGINA showed little. ZAYLA dropped back after an even beginning and was outrun.
